

Getting Started in Journey:

There are two toolbars used for navigation and settings and three Shortcuts

Shortcuts:

Two Finger Tap:

A simple tap with two fingers together will toggle the toolbars on or off

Two Finger Swipe:

Simply swipe two fingers horizontally across the screen to go to the next/previous tab

Three Finger Tap:

A simple tap with three fingers will activate the settings menu

Search in a new tab



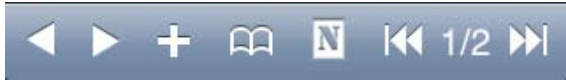
Tap here to activate keyboard to enter URL.

Add a bookmark, find in page, adjust settings, mail the current page, or open the page in Safari. For more detail see below



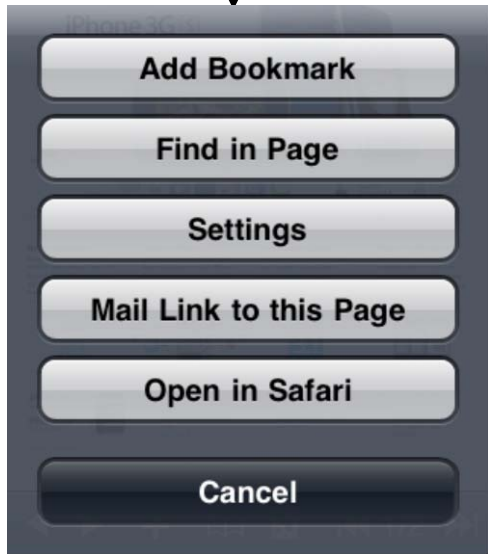

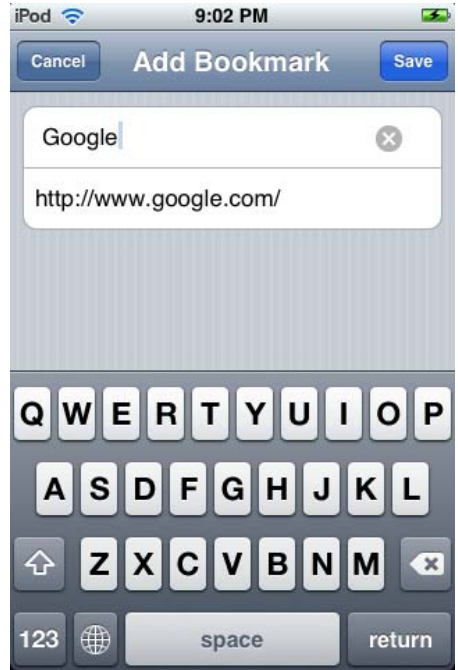

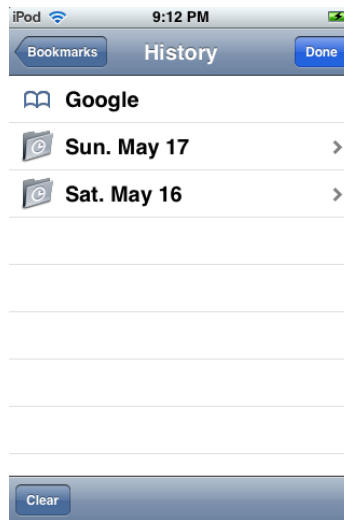
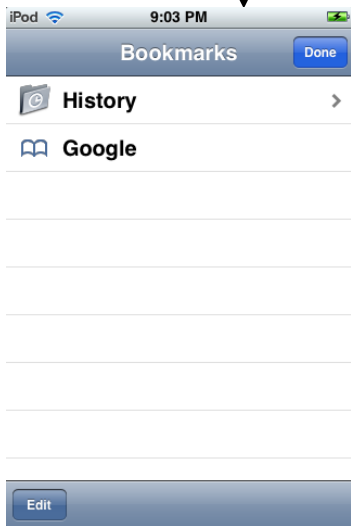
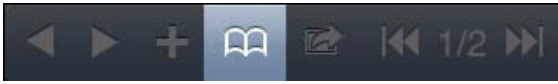
Go to next/previous tab. Numbers indicate how many tabs are open



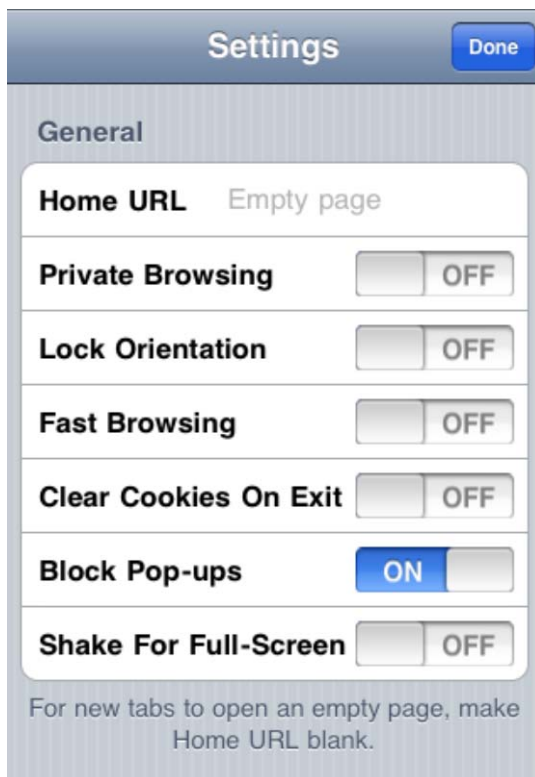

Settings menu page 1 –scroll down to see page 2



Home page for new tab. ** *When you re-open Journey, it automatically restores the last open pages*

Private browse, NO history stored

Lock in portrait or landscape mode

Pages load up to ten times faster.

No cookies for your milk after you close Journey

Blocks pop-ups. If set to OFF pop-up appears in new tab

Shake device to toggle full screen, for those who don't like a three finger tap

Pretend to be spoofs your user-agent so that web sites think you are a different browser. This is useful for sites that require you to use IE.
